My dear Brother Knights:

Welcome back to what promises to be a new and rewarding year for us as a Council. One of the interesting phenomenon that we can observe in the Old Testament is that the Israelites never saw historical events in a purely secular way. Adopting that mindset might well be a good way to approach this new year. We'll be observing the fourth anniversary of 9/11 within days of the new year beginning. Our world has changed drastically since then. What is God saying to us as individuals and as communities through this "new world"?

As a fraternal organization so closely associated with the Church, it might be a good question for us to pray over as we begin this year. It might be a good lens for us to view all our efforts this year: What is God trying to say to us in this new year 2005-06 as a fraternity, a society, as a Church, and a country?
