Whereas John Didden is an able School Administrator of great integrity committed to high ethical standards in the education of our children, and

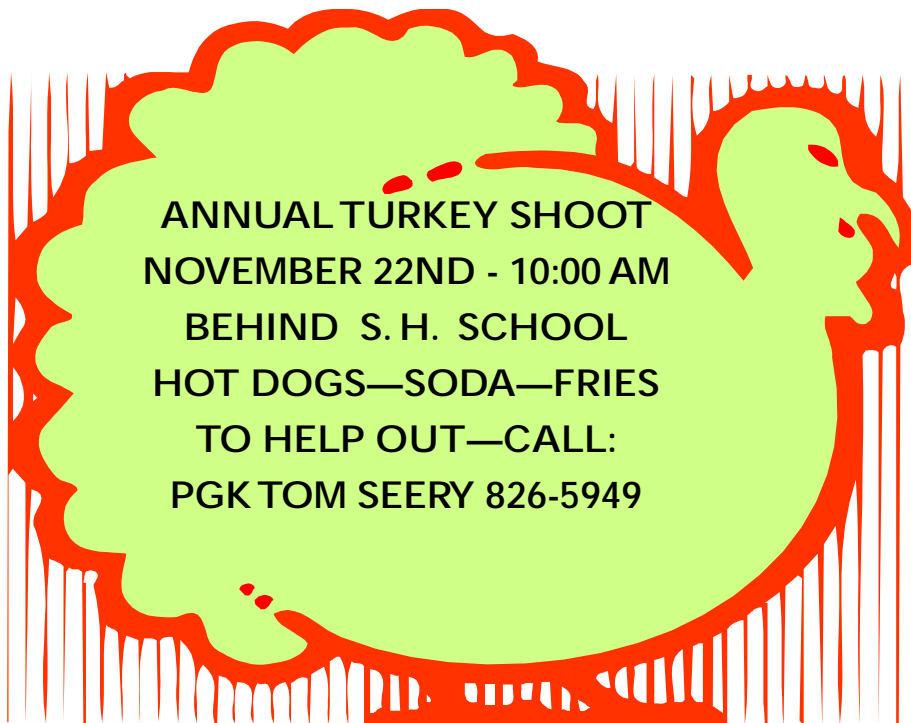
Whereas, John Didden is a dedicated, active participant and leader in the Bellmore-Merrick community activities including Scouting and Little League for more than 20 years, and
