KNIGHTS REAFFIRM POSITION ON CATHOLICS IN POLITICS

At this year's Annual Convention, Supreme reaffirmed our long standing policy of not inviting to K of C events those public officials or candidates for public office who support abortion, euthanasia or assisted suicide, and denying such officials and candidates any of the order's honors or use of its facilities.

Noting that "the principle of separation of church and state does not require separating moral principles and political choices," the Supreme Council resolved to: "continue to speak out to our elected representatives of the responsibility to protect human life at all stages, and of the need to elect representatives prepared to enact such legislation."

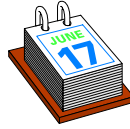
